

RULES FOR SAFE HANDLING OF WEAPONS WORK SHEET

Safety is very important when weapons are being handled or fired. Accidents are generally caused by faulty or careless handling of weapons and ammunition.

The following rules apply, at all times, to handling of weapons:

1. A weapon must never be 1 at anyone in any 2.
2. A weapon must always be handled so that it 3 in such a direction that there is no danger if a round is 4 fired.
3. Whenever a weapon is 5 up, which has not been under an individual's direct 6 it must be 8 to make sure that it is not 7. i.e. Normal Safety Precautions (NSP's) must be carried out.
4. The 9 of a weapon must never be rested against any part of the 10.
5. Whenever a weapon is 11 to someone else he/she must first be shown that it is 12 (clear). When anyone else hands a weapon to him/her he/she must insist that the same action is taken.
6. A weapon must be in the unloaded state prior to travelling in a vehicle or during 13 moves on 14.
7. A 15 must never be allowed to fire a weapon unless he/she has been 16 and 17 in its use under supervision. A period of revision should be conducted on the weapon prior to 18 firing.
8. When conducting training with weapons, cadets should, at all time, carry their DP or GP rifle or LSW with the 19 fitted, except when undergoing formal 20 ground drill.
