Instructors Notes

The aim of testing

The aim of testing a cadet in each subject at each star level is to ensure he has absorbed what he has been taught and that he is able to apply that knowledge practically.

The aim of this test

The aim of the test is to confirm that the cadet has a good understanding of the ACF at county level, his or her place in the county and the APC syllabus as a whole.

The test Design

The design of the test has the advantages of;

1. Cost affective due to minimal printing.
2. Cadets with learning difficulties will not have the added burden of reading questions or writing answers.
3. Minimal stores are required (i.e. pens and paper)
4. The randomness of question selection encourages the cadets to learn the complete subject matter.

How the test should be run

The Test should be run as follows;

1. The question number cutouts should be cut out and placed in a pot (one per question type).
2. The cadet should then be invited to choose two questions from each pot.
3. The instructor should then read the relevant questions to the cadet and record on the record sheet if the answer given was correct or not.
4. The cadet should then be informed of the correct answers to any wrongly answered questions and told if they passed or failed the test.

Notes for the tester

1. This test complies with principles of testing laid down within the syllabus (ref – Chap 1, Section 12, Para 0162).
2. Out of the two questions asked from each question type only one must be answered correctly to qualify as a pass.
3. The instructor is allowed to reword or explain questions, if the cadet does not understand, however the instructor should not give the answer away when rewording/explaining.
4. Due to the nature of the test some answers will change over time. It is the instructor's responsibility to make sure that all answers are correct at the time of testing.
5. The cadets should not be encouraged to learn the answers from the question answer sheet parrot fashion.
